On May 3, 2010 over 50 people gathered at Riverdale Park in downtown Toronto to participate in the annual Hike for Hospice which raised over \$50,000. The event which takes each spring raises funds in support of palliative care organizations such as Perram House that provide medical care and emotional support to people living with terminal illness.

In 2010 Perram House participated in the event for the 5th year raising over \$8,500 with the help of volunteers that braved the spring showers.

The Hike for Hospice opens National Hospice Palliative Care Week that runs across Canada from May 3rd to 9th, 2010. All funds raised at Riverdale Park went to support the work of Alliance Hospice, Casey House, Philip Aziz Center, Hospice Toronto and Perram House.

Perram House - Perram House is an 8 bed residential hospice located in downtown Toronto that provides 24 x 7 residential care and day programs to its patients which are facilitated by a professional team of doctors, nurses, personal services workers (PSW) and volunteers. The program delivered at Perram House is a role model for the healthcare industry, emphasizing patient centric care and the application of best practices and continuous improvement.
